

Example Daily Lesson Plan: Third Grade

<p>Skills Practice Time: 8:30</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Syllable Cards and Mystery Word for Big 4 Prefixes (Rule 24). Bring (10) 5 X 7 cards with words that have prefixes. (5 min.) Mystery Words/Decoding: <i>unhappy, distend, instinct, remain</i> Mystery Words: Encoding: <i>revenge, distrust, intend, unless</i> Write poem (Shakespeare on board (in advance). Have class read it. Discuss new vocabulary in lines 1 – 3: <i>dale, brier, orb, swifter, sphere</i>, etc. Discuss the meaning of these lines. Introduce weekly spelling words (Zaner Bloser list 5): Pretest, correct, review the rule

Introduction or Review: Time: 9:00	Story to Introduce Adjectives: Princess Adjective Activity: Describe nouns* (chapter 3.11.8b) Try to come up with original adjectives that others will not select. <i>*Supplies: book, shoe, recorder, building block, apple, flower, stuffed bear, leaf</i>
Transition Time: 9:20	Set up for bookwork + visit "upside down world"
Bookwork Time: 9:25	Drawing of Princess Adjective and objects Caption: Adjectives describe nouns
Transition Time: 9:55	Movement song: "On the Day I Went to Sea" pirate song
Story Time 10:00- 10:15	Old Testament Story: "How Enos Brought the Worship of Idols to Humankind"
